



# Emmons Scholarship Packets Available

*Deadline is March 1- Early Bird Deadline is February 16*

Scholarship packets for the 2012 Roger W. Emmons Memorial Scholarship are now available at the ORRA office. **The Oregon Student Access Commission (OSAC) must receive the completed application, including all related materials, by midnight, March 1, 2012.**

**Please Note:** applications may only be submitted online – paper applications are no longer available.

**Early Bird Scholarship Deadline:** Any applicant that: 1) carefully follows instructions, and, 2) submits a completed error-free application packet by **February 16, 2012**, is automatically entered to win a \$500 Early Bird Scholarship. If the application is incomplete, OSAC will send notification and the applicant will have until midnight, March 1, 2012, to submit any missing or incorrect information or documents.

ORRA established the Emmons scholarship in the memory of ORRA's first Executive Director, Roger W. Emmons. To date, 54 scholarships have been awarded to deserving students. Thanks to the hard work of the **Emmons Memorial Scholarship Committee** and those who participate in and contribute to the annual charity golf tournament, the funds have increased to allow for the academic scholarship to become a four-year renewable award and the vocational scholarship to become a two-year renewable award. The scholarship (both academic and vocational) is offered to a high school graduating senior who is a child or grandchild of an owner or employee (if employed three or more years) of an ORRA solid waste company regular member. High school graduating seniors do not have to graduate from an Oregon school to qualify. The scholarship may be used to attend any accredited school in the United States.
